

Individual learning accounts: public consultation launched

The European Commission has launched a public consultation on Individual learning accounts, open until 16 July 2021.

Feedback is invited on the problem definition, need for EU action and policy objectives, policy options and expected impacts.

The twin digital and green transitions and the disruptions induced by COVID-19 bring about significant structural changes on labour markets and will fundamentally change the skills requirements of many jobs. This increases the importance of building skills throughout life to bridge skills gaps, support labour market transitions and foster social inclusion.

At the same time, an increasing share of individuals (e.g. workers in atypical forms of work such as part time, temporary and platform workers and the self-employed) are at risk of not receiving sufficient support for training from an employer.
